



CODE OF ETHICS FOR SEANZ MEMBERS

Members of the Sustainable Electricity Association New Zealand shall undertake to agree with the Code of Ethics of the Association. In particular they:

1. Shall act so as to uphold the integrity of SEANZ by associating their business activities with other members of the association, individuals and enterprises of good character.
2. Shall apply their skills and knowledge ethically in the interest of their clients or employers for whom they act.
3. Shall solicit work, sales and advertising to promote their products and services with integrity, avoiding any misleading statements or omissions.
4. Shall regard as confidential any information concerning the business and technical affairs of their employers and clients.
5. Shall inform their clients or employers if circumstances arise such that their services may be compromised by reason of business connections or affiliations.
6. Shall continue where possible their professional development by keeping abreast of latest technologies and products and also encourage and teach others by passing on this knowledge and experience.
7. Shall deal honestly and truthfully with clients and employers in all matters regarding payments, discounts, rebates, grants or conditions applying to them.
8. Shall observe and conform to all relevant rules, standards and codes set down by SEANZ and or appropriate regulatory board.
9. Shall promptly report any breach of the above clause 8 by an accredited member of SEANZ, to a member of the board.
10. Shall report any apparent breach of the above rules by a non accredited member to a board member of the SEANZ so that those individuals may be encouraged to follow the SEANZ Code.
